

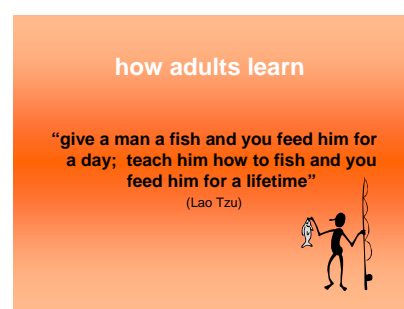
# Impressions of a Workshop in a Changing World<sup>©</sup>

Collectively we set the Workshop's objectives and its framework.



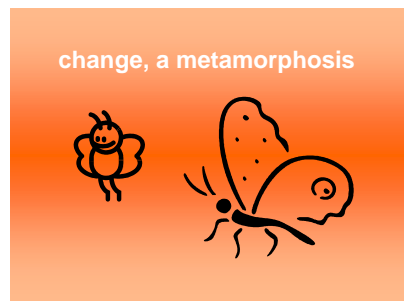
We enjoyed a concerted "catch" but allowed ourselves individual feeding and digestion!

We saw that as our perception changes, the object we observe and try to explain changes too!



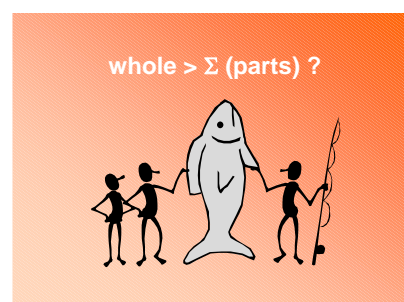
We compared changes in shallow lakes behaviour with the caterpillar-butterfly model.
